TEAM CRITERIA

Players must be in Primary School and aged 8-12 at the time of the carnival TO PARTICIPATE ON FRIDAY

Players must be aged 12 years or older at the time of the carnival TO PARTICIPATE ON SATURDAY

Players cannot play in more than one team.

Each team must have a minimum of 8 players, and maximum of 12 players.

Each team must have at least two female players and at least two players under the age of 18 years.

There must be at least 6 Indigenous players in each team on the field playing during an allotted game.

TEAM POINT SYSTEM

Each team will have a maximum allocation of 20 points.

The following allocation applies:

<i>Played Imparja Cup over 5yrs ago</i>	<i>2.5 points</i>
<i>Played for Qld over 5yrs ago</i>	<i>5 points</i>

<i>Played for Aus over 5yrs ago</i>	<i>7.5 points</i>
<i>Played for Qld in the past 5yrs</i>	<i>10 points</i>

Rules and Regulations

SUPER 8'S CRICKET

Game Rules

- Each game shall be played between two (2) teams of eight (8) players.
- A game consists of a maximum of eight (8), six (6) ball overs per team.
- A team shall not be permitted to declare its innings closed.
- A game should take no longer than (one) 1 hour to complete.

Bowling

- Each member of the team must bowl one (1) over.
- Bowlers are to have a run up of no more than ten (10) metres.
- The ball used will be a Kookaburra Softaball (or equivalent).
- Underarm bowling is allowed.
- Boundary fours (4) are to be scored as normal.
- A ball passing over the boundary on the full is scored as eight (8) runs.
- A maximum of eight (8) balls per over is allowed.

* The final over of an innings must consist of six (6) legal deliveries. •

A wide shall be counted as one (1) extra run to the batting team.

- A wide ball is to be rebowled.
- A no-ball shall be counted as one (1) extra run to the batting team.
- A no-ball is to be rebowled.
- A no-ball is called when:

Bowler steps over the front bowling crease

Ball bounces over shoulder height of the batter

Ball passes the batter on the full, above waist height

Batting

- A batter must retire immediately at the score of twenty (25).
- They may resume their innings at the fall of the last wicket.
- Retired batters with the lowest score resume their innings first at the fall of the last wicket

Game Results

- The team with the highest score at the end of the match will be declared the winner.
- If the scores of both teams are equal at the end of the game, the team losing the least amount of wickets will be declared the winner

Event Terms & Conditions

Officials

- Game umpires and event officials will be readily identifiable in shirts indicated with 'Official' on the back of shirts worn on the day of the event.

Clothing

- Registered players to wear team shirts, cricket shirt or white cricket polo shirt is preferred. Cricket trousers or board shorts are accepted. Footwear is to be worn, cricket shoes or joggers with suitable sole are preferred to prevent injury.

Competition Format

- Each team will play round matches with points allocated for each match as set out below.
- WIN 2 points
- DRAW 1 point
- LOSS 0 points
- **Please note:** it is important scorers record for all batsmen whether they are out, retired or not out.
